

# ESTABLISHING A PREMIER SCHOOL LIBRARY

## TWIN RIVERS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT | CA

The Twin Rivers Unified School District established a state-of-theart library for its new TK-8 school site. This project represents a significant milestone for the district, as it is the first new school built and opened since the consolidation of several smaller districts into one. The new facility, featuring flexible seating and a Makerspace, sets a new standard for educational environments within the district.

#### PLANNING AND COLLABORATION

From the outset, the district recognized the importance of creating a fully furnished and stocked library. With that information in-hand, the district held its first meeting with Follett Content. This brainstorming session was crucial in understanding the district's needs, including enrollment, book types, demographics, and the physical layout of the library. Discussions covered shelving, capacity, and other logistical details. This initial meeting helped outline the budget and explore options for FollettBound®, hardbound, and softbound books.

Following this, the district gathered more information about the furnishings and the library's capacity before holding another meeting to review updates and finalize decisions on spine placement and whether to use True Dewey or genrefication. As the only employee at the time, Firpo relied heavily on Follett Content, and Joshua Crotts, the district's Instructional Materials Coordinator for guidance. Firpo stated, "The decision to genrefy the library considering the TK-8 student population – was strategic in making the library more accessible. This approach allows any staff member to assist students in finding books, fostering independence and ease of use."

One of the most significant challenges was curating the book list. With no prior experience in opening a library, the district found Follett Content's support invaluable. They provided a Titlewave® account and shared various lists, helping navigate budget considerations and binding options.
